



## Murray High School P&C Student Scholarship Application

Murray High School (MHS) and the Parents and Citizens' Association (P&C) are committed to providing increased opportunities for students to develop their talents and represent MHS in their chosen field(s).

In recognition of the Academic, Sporting and Cultural achievements of exceptional students, the P&C have much pleasure in offering Scholarships for students at MHS. The scholarships on offer are represented through the following categories:

- Academic Excellence
- Sporting Excellence
- Creative Arts Excellence

The recipients will be selected for their achievements in their chosen field and commitment to promoting the values of MHS. Scholarships represent an approximate value of \$300.00 per application. The scholarships are intended to offset expenditure across academic and extra-curricular areas. (Note: There will be a limit of \$2,100.00 in scholarship funds allocated annually. In special cases applicants can request a higher scholarship award with a cap at \$1,000.00. Awards will be considered and offered on a first come basis until all funds are exhausted for the representative calendar school year. Any funds not issued will be rolled over into the P&C's respective funding account.

Subject to approval by the P&C, scholarships will be offered annually. Unsuccessful applicants may apply in future years. Scholarship recipients are expected to be role models participating fully in all facets of MHS life.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applicants will apply by completing and submitting the Scholarship Application Form for consideration. Applications must be fully completed and include all required documentation. Incomplete applications will not be processed and returned back to applicants.

Documentation supporting a student's application must be provided to the P&C by one of the monthly meetings, which normally occurs on the second Monday of each month, no less than 30 days of the required funding so the P&C have ample time to review the application. Applications must include:

- A written letter from the student, no more than 50 words, detailing why they require the scholarship, the amount required and how will it contribute to the development of personal excellence in the school community.
- Summary and evidence of areas of excellence.
- Reference from MHS or another Representative (Written references are not required). Simply list the name and contact details of the person who is supporting the student application, such as a teacher, sports coach or performing arts school. P&C selectors will contact referees if necessary.

The information provided by the applicant will be used to determine the successful scholarship applicants. Applicants may choose to be considered for more than one category but can only receive one scholarship per school year. It is recommended the applicant focuses on their area of strength such as; academic, sport or culture, to give them the best opportunity for success. Recipients will be announced once the selection process has been completed. Parents/Caregivers and students will be invited to a special ceremony where the scholarship will be officially presented. This can take place at the annual MHS Awards Day at the end of the school year or simply presented at the monthly P&C meetings.
