## Responding to Bullying Reports 2021

- If conflict is a first occurrence, it isn't bullying. Refer serious incidents to Head Teacher or Deputy Principal.
- Follow up on behaviour not adhering to values of being Ready, Respectful, Responsible. Changing friendship groups doesn't constitute bullying, however, students may still require wellbeing support.
- Provide strategies for students to deal with the conflict.
- Communicate with Year Adviser or other Wellbeing staff.
- Check-ins with students, encouragement to report back if any further incidents occur.
- Document the incident on SENTRAL.

- If second report indicates ongoing conflict, referral to Wellbeing Team (Year Adviser, SSO, Head Teacher Wellbeing) for specific intervention. Refer serious incidents to Head Teacher or Deputy Principal.
- Check-ins with students, encouragement to report back if any further incidents occur.
- Parental contact for all students involved.
- Document the incident on SENTRAL.

Second report

- Referral to Wellbeing Team and Deputy Principal, intervention may include disciplinary process, mediation/restorative conference.
- Check-ins with students, encouragement to report back if any further incidents occur.
- · Parental contact for all students involved.
- · Document the incident on SENTRAL.
